School Attendance

Regular school attendance is vital for every child within our school. Missed lessons mean missed opportunities to have full access to the curriculum. If your child is absent from school, please ensure that you send a written explanation on your child's return to school. We would have concerns if your child's attendance falls below 87%.

Those with an attendance between 85-87% will receive a note to allow awareness and encourage improvement.



Those below 85% will be invited to school to have a conversation on how best to increase their child's attendance.

By law we must inform the Educational Welfare Officer if their attendance is 85% or below. Attendance will be continuously monitored throughout the school year.

We appreciate all your support in this important matter and thank you for encouraging your child to always attend.

Room 4 - Visit to the Irish Cottages Exhibition at the Flax Museum



On Thursday 11th April the P7 pupils visited the Flax Museum, in Upperlands to find out more about Irish cottages which they had come across in their learning about famine times in Ireland.

Mr Garry McIlwaine showed them a very interesting presentation about cottages which stimulated their thinking and fed into their level of knowledge about their current World Around Us topic. The pupils were then able to look at the various cottage models from the exhibition by Dick Clark and were encouraged to observe the various features of a traditional Irish cottage or cabin as they were actually known.

Mr McIlwaine then took us on an educational adventure to see the original

thatched mill cottage in the grounds of the former Clark's Linen factory where they saw the features of a real and historically important thatched building for themselves.

The pupils had a great time bringing history to life and seeing parts of our Historic Linen Village, some for the first time.

Thank you Mr McIlwaine for your invitation to visit the exhibition and for making it so memorable and relevant for us all.
